I am glad to learn that the Department of Higher Education is bringing out a quarterly e - News Letter to enlighten the latest developments in the department to its stakeholders.





This period has witnessed many milestones reached, several success reaped and intense attempts made in marching towards the goal.

Highlights: -

- Tele Education in 73 Govt. colleges in Hyderabad Karnataka region is being established. This facility with provision for two way interaction between the subject expert in the studio and the students in the tele Education through EDUSAT Satellite program has technologically connected 327 Govt. colleges with the newly installed EDUSAT broadcast studio. The regularly telecasted spoken English and computer fundamental classes have benefited number of students across the State. The EDUSAT also being utilized for developing administrative support through interactions between the Directorate and Principals of the Institutions.
- The Govt. has waived off the tuition fee and laboratory fee for girl students of private aided First Grade Colleges. This benevolent gesture will help over 1.25 lakh girl students.
- The year 2013-2014 has witnessed an increase of over 22% in student strength compared to previous years.

• To meet the needs of the growing number of Students, construction of 51 new hostels was undertaken. Further in this effort construction of 20 more hostels is being taken up with an additional grant.

Global Shapers Programme.

The future leaders come from among the present day students. To develop leadership skills among students, 5000 PG/UG Students of various Government Colleges across the State were provided with Corporate Leadership training in collaboration with Global Shapers, an initiative of the World Economic Forum.

Placement cell.

Forging link between Students and Industry, Placement cells have been established in all Govt. First Grade Colleges. For the first time in the state, 76 students of Government First Grade Colleges have been selected in the campus selection by Wipro under its 'Earn cum Learn' scheme. These students need not have to pay any tution fee and also each of them will be granted a total stipend of Rs. 8 Lakh for 4 years to pursue MS/MTech. program offered by prestigious Institutes like BITS, Pilani and Vellore Institute of Technology, Vellore.

As part of a further Initiative, Training the Trainer program is underway. Under this programme the IT major Infosys is imparting an in-house training to the placement Coordinators and Nipunyanidhi Coorinators of the Government First Grade Colleges. At present five batches of teachers have already been trained under this programme. In the year 2014-15 morethan 3,779 student for various GFGC's have been selected by various MNC's including Wipro, Infosys, TCS, Tech Mahendra etc.,

Rashtreeya Uchchtara Shiksha Abhiyaan (RUSA).

Rashtreeya Uchchtara Shiksha Abhiyaan (RUSA), a scheme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, aims at improving the quality of Higher Education by building infrastructure in Higher Education Institutions. For availing the benefit under this scheme, proposals from 355 colleges, with an estimated cost of Rs. 2222.95 crore have been submitted to the MHRD.



Implementation of Transfer Act

With the intension to overcome the shortage of staff by posting teaching & non-teaching staff on equal ratio to all the Institutions existing in various regions specially to the backward regions and to bring transparency and good system, Transfer Act was implemented during 2014-15. As per the direction and advice of the Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education, the general transfer was reduced to the minimum.

Action Plan for 2014-15

For the first time the action plan for the year 2014 – 15 was prepared and approved in the month of July itself by the honourable minister for Higher Education, to provide quality education, to enhance the placement opportunity and to develop the labs in the 10 Govt. Engineering Colleges and 43 Govt. Polytechnics at the earliest to help the poor and meritorious students studying in these colleges.

Pro -Active Initiatives during CET 2014.



- The Government has introduced 5% Supernumerary (SNQ) Quota seats over and above the total Government seats available in each Engineering College to benefit the poor and meritorious students who are not coming under any category and these seats with full fee concession are being offered to such students.
- ➤ CET 2015 Online: Candidates aspiring to write CET will henceforth apply online for CET 2015. Applicants will be provided with all guidance. The following will be the advantages of this method:
 - There will be one month's time for final submission of application in online system where as earlier it was only one week.
 - There will be one time provision for correction / deletion / addition for the submitted online application.

- CET 2015 time table is already published 3 months in advance and the entire process pf application submission is likely to completed by mid February 2015.
- ➤ Karnataka is emerging as a knowledge State in the country and needs to take on the 21 century global challenges in terms of Innovation, conservation of heritage, generation of new knowledge, application of knowledge in every sphere of life, skill development, enhancement of competencies, creation of better human capital to create new knowledge economy besides creation of single humane society. Keeping in line with the setting up of National Knowledge Commission at the Centre the Karnataka Jnana Aayoga (Karnataka Knowledge Commission) was constituted under the guidance and Chairmanship of renowned space scientist Dr. K. Kasturirangan. Recognizing the important role to be played by the commission in making Karnataka a Knowledge Society, the present Government reconstituted the Karnataka Inana Aayoga in December 2013 under the Chairmanship of Dr. K. Kasturirangan.
- Development of a **Nursing Simulator** is a unique innovative project that will bring immense benefit to train nurses and critical care doctors. The development is being taken up by Dr. Devi Shetty and Prof. Gurumoorthy, IISc who have prepared a joint proposal including scope, milestones, responsibility sharing, commercialisation and issues relating to Intellectual Property. KJA will assess this and the project will be taken up through IISc, Bangalore.
- ➤ Waste water Management Guidelines Study- At the behest of BBMP and Urban Development Dept., KJA plans to study and recommend the best way for waste water management in Karnataka cities. A workshop is planned to be organised in this regard and KJA will steer for preparing a report on this important issue.
- Smart-City Definition Study at the behest of Urban Development Department, KJA plans to study and recommend ways and means of developing Smart City.
- ➤ The Karnataka State Innovation Council Was reconstituted in march 2014, under the chairmanship of Prof. H P C Khincha. The primary objective of the council is to ignite the spirit of innovation in the citizens of the State across industry, Education, Governance and Social sectors.



- ➤ Permissions have been granted to start 7 new Private Universities in the State in addition to the 2 Private Universities already functioning in the State.
- Parents Relation Centre (PRC) has been established, in all the Universities and Colleges. This is a novel student- centric measure, taking parents into confidence in the education of their children to address the issues such as dropout rate, attendance, parental awareness for supporting their children at the house, drug addiction and possible psychological disturbance if any.
- Establishment of an Employment Advisory Cell (EAC) in association with the Federation of Karnataka chambers of commerce and Industry (FKCCI) in all the Universities: A key aspect of the courses offered in Higher Educational Institutions should be employment potential. In order to provide more employment opportunities, particularly for the basic Sciences. Humanities and Social Science students on an equal platform, KSHEC has approved the establishment of EAC. It enables the Counseling / Placement, meeting for

- students of all subjects at the end of the term examinations. This novel initiative brings Industry and Higher Education together for the first time in the State to address employment problems of students.
- A uniform academic calendar for all Universities: As there is no uniform academic calendar, students are facing problems in pursuing their higher education due to delay in announcement of results, to get their admission for further studies and jobs. Hence it has been decided to adopt the recommendations of the committee under the chairmanship Prof. T. C. Shivashankaramurthy, former Vice-Chancellor, Mangalore.
- National Eligibility Test (NET)/State Level Entrance Test (SLET)/State Eligibility Test (SET) is compulsory while recruiting teachers in Colleges/Universities: As per the UGC guidelines, it has been decided to make NET/SLET/SET examinations compulsory for the direct recruitment for the post of Assistant Professors in Colleges and Universities.

EDUCATION AND BEST PRACTICES:

In the connected world where we live, it is imperative that education is treated as the only glue that can ensure that the world flourishes. Education itself is a best practice that can happen in ones life. It should teach us humility and benevolence and a clarity of mind and purpose. I am reminded of Bhirthrihari the celebrated author of Shatakatrayi who wrote in Sanskrit and translated in English means "With fruits, trees bend, i.e. be humble, with water, clouds hang low, i.e. wealthy good men maintain humble posture, and hence are seen to be benevolent.

In my view it is not unfair to suggest that institutions of higher education have always been created and shaped by the interests of the ruling classes and elites in the societies in which they existed. This means they serve to reinforce the economic, political, ideological, and cultural interests of those who create them, fund them, and populate them. We need to take a hard look at this proposition and make education available to everyone who needs it. A truly inclusive system is in everyone's interest.

Private, Public and Governmental participation has been steadily increasing in the education sector. Forecasts suggest that, if current patterns of participation continue, more than 30% of today's school leavers will experience higher education in 10 years from now. A GER of about 18% would certainly need to be revisited and the Governments Endeavour to push it as high as 30% is indeed noble. I wish, we attain a figure of 50% in probably the next 20 odd years. Higher education will shape individual lives, the economy and society. Such an activity must be the subject of broad and informed consideration and debate.

We need to empower the youth with education that promotes knowledge and promotes meaningful employment based on this knowledge as applicable to a certain environment. Any activity that promotes this is a best practice and such a pursuit will always benefit the society we live. The foremost three aspects of education are-the student, the faculty and the Institution.

A Country blesssed with great numbers of youth in productive age can also be severly undercut if they are not in the mainstream. An example would suffice the seriousness of this statement. Over 50% of youth fail between 10th, 11th and 12th grade and probably out of the education scene for ever after that. They surely must be contributing to the growth of the Country in some way as much as contributing to the muck.

An out of box approach and a possible best practice could be to allow them to pass the grade with minimal intervention. The Government's move to exempt Xth grade examinations is truly out of box, critics apart, and worth a million in the bullion market. We need more of that

Assuming an incremental value addition happens to the entropy of the Universe, it is still worth it apart from the collateral advantage of higher GER's and overall growth in economies brought about by an exalted youth

For real progress, we need to lead our education paradigm upfront inspired to conceive beyond the norms, into new paradigms of learning, with aspirations above what has been previously achieved for teachers, trainers and learners and transforming the same into behaviours that realise the aspirations and inspire development. One great incongruity in our system has been development of an organised sector of barely 10% when the developed world over, the figure is in the excess of 80%, and a total neglect of the so called unorganised sector whose development, in reality has unheard potential for many of the ills of this country.. Hence, Skills development, both in the organised and the unorganised sector and training as an education imperative is an extremely important activity for a growing economy such as ours. Every student who goes through higher education will be well served if he or she has additional skills acquired along with his / her studies.. It enhances the employability opportunities. On the other hand, skills, acquired by a student who does not go through a formal education would provide a means of self-employment and also a chance for employment in the formal focused skill development, with employability as the maxim, is the need of the day. We also need to realise that our youth coming from the kind of financial means that they have, would need to be sustained on some minimal financial incentive to pursue skills for employment and hence we need credible financial models to sustain education for youth. We need to inspire, achieve and engage our youth, wean them away from divisive forces, build them into a formidable force to pitchfork the economy to be positioned at a higher plane and of course create a WIN-WIN for everyone so that, again like Sant Kabir said "Kala NalaHeen Jal, So Phir Paani Hoye, Jo Paani Moti Bhaya, So PhirNeer Na Hoye", Ice becomes water in the course of time. The water that has become a pearl will never again become water. We need to convert all our youth into those pearls.

Best practices in Education is notional at best though specifics can always be defined. Anything that adds to overall well-being and acts as a force multiplier for economy is a best practice be it in education, medicine economies or any other.

ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣವು ಭಾರತದ ಬೆಳವಣಿಗೆಗೆ ತುಂಬಾ ಸಹಕಾರಿಯಾಗಿದೆ. ಏಕೆಂದರೆ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣವು ದೇಶದ ಪ್ರಗತಿಯನ್ನು ದುಪ್ಪಟ್ಟು ಮಾಡುತ್ತದೆ. ಬೇರೆ ಮುಂದುವರಿದ ದೇಶಗಳಿಗೆ ಹೋಲಿಕೆ ಮಾಡಿದರೆ ಭಾರತದಲ್ಲಿ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣವು ತುಂಬಾ ಕಡಿಮೆ ಇದೆ.ಅಂದರೆ ಶೇ.13% ಕ್ಕಿಂತ ಕಡಿಮೆ ಅಮೇರಿಕಾ 80% & ಚೀನಾ 23% ಗಿಂತ ಅಧಿಕವಿದೆ. ಇದರಿಂದ ಒಂದು ಗೊತ್ತಾಗುವ ವಿಷಯವೆಂದರೆ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣದ ಬೆಳವಣಿಗೆ ಭಾರತಕ್ಕೆ ತುಂಬಾ ಅವಶ್ಯಕವಾಗಿದೆ.

ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣದ ಬೆಳವಣಿಗೆಗೆ ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯದ ನಂತರ ಭಾರತ ಸರ್ಕಾರ ಅನೇಕ ಯೋಜನೆಗಳನ್ನು ಹಾಕಿಕೊಂಡಿತ್ತು. 1956 ರಲ್ಲಿ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ಧನ ಸಹಾಯ ಆಯೋಗ (ಯುಜಿಸಿ) ಯನ್ನು ಸ್ಥಾಪನೆ ಮಾಡಿದರು. ಇದು MHRDಯ ಸ್ವತಂತ್ರ ಅಂಗ ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಯಾಗಿದೆ. ಈ ಆಯೋಗದ ಮುಖಾಂತರ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳು, ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳು ಹೆಚ್ಚು ಹೆಚ್ಚು ಸ್ಥಾಪನೆಯಾಗುತ್ತಿವೆ. ಧನ ಸಹಾಯ ಮಾಡಿ ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳು & ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳು ಹೆಚ್ಚಾಗಲು ಕಾರಣವಾಯಿತು. ಇದರಿಂದ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣದ ಗುಣಮಟ್ಟವನ್ನು ಹೆಚ್ಚಿಸುತ್ತಿದೆ. 1950 ರಲ್ಲಿ 20 ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳಿದ್ದವು. ಇಂದು 677 ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳಾಗಿವೆ. 1950 ರಲ್ಲಿ 500 ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳು ಮಾತ್ರಇದ್ದವು. 2013 ರಲ್ಲಿ 37000 ಕ್ಕಿಂತ ಹೆಚ್ಚು ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳಿವೆ. ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣವ ಬಹಳ ಕ್ಷಿಪ್ರಗತಿಯಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಗತಿಯಾಗುತ್ತಿವೆ. ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣದ ಬೆಳವಣಿಗೆಗಾಗಿ ಕೇಂದ್ರ ಮತ್ತು ರಾಜ್ಯ ಸರ್ಕಾರಗಳು ತುಂಬಾ ಪ್ರೋತ್ಸಾಹದಾಯಕವಾದ ಅಂಶಗಳನ್ನು ಅಳವಡಿಸುತ್ತಿವೆ. ಇದರಿಂದಾಗಿ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ಮತ್ತು ಕಾಲೇಜುಗಳ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ ಅಧಿಕವಾಗಿ ಅಲ್ಲಿ ವ್ಯಾಸಂಗ ಮಾಡುತ್ತಿರುವ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆಯೂ ಸಹ ಹೆಚ್ಚಾಗುತ್ತಿದೆ

Websites for Colleges:

Website is the e-identity of any institution. To facilitate information gleaning process easier for all the stakeholders, Websites are being created with the help of NIC for all the Government First Grade Colleges. Faculty from each college are being trained to create and maintain the website of their college. This initiative will slash costs, avoid dependence on third party and prevent inordinate delays in updating the college websites.



Filling up of Teaching Posts through Karnataka Examination Authority:

Hitherto, selection for teaching posts in Government First Grade Colleges was done by KPSC. To encourage transparency in appointments, the Government has granted permission to Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) to fill up 2160 vacancies in the Teaching cadre in Government First GradeColleges through Common Entrance Test (CET). Absence of interview in the selection process is the special feature of this initiative.

Education Management Information System (e-MIS): Web-based online Education Management Information System (e-MIS) is designed to collect and compile essential data, concerning the academic and administrative issues online, from all the Government

First Grade Colleges. The e-MIS also comprises of class work management module and integrated SMS facility to capture information from colleges regarding classes engaged and not engaged on daily basis. The e-MIS software was developed in collaboration with N.I.C., Bangalore.

Face Identifying Biometric Attendance System:

Adopting technology to achieve precision, transparency and heightened efficiency in faculty attendance surveillance, unique and reliable SIM based online Face and Finger Identification Attendance Monitoring Systems have been installed in Government Colleges and Offices of the Department of Collegiate Education. The staff attendance in Government Degree Colleges, Regional Offices and Head office is being monitored centrally from Head Office.

The Higher Education Council under the Chairmanship of Sri R V Deshpande, Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education and Tourism, has taken the following new initiatives. Establishment of an Employment Advisory Cell (EAC) in association with the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FKCCI) in all the Universities.

A Key aspect of the courses offered in higher educational institutions is an employment potential. In order to provide more employment opportunities, particularly for the basic sciences, humanities and social science students on an equal platform, KSHEC has approved the establishment of It enables to counselling/placement meetings for students of all subjects at the end of the term examinations. This novel initiative brings an industry and higher education together for the first time in the state to address employment problems of students.

A uniform policy for admission to international students.

Number of students from overseas are seeking admissions to various degree courses in state universities. The procedure for such admissions is varies from university to university.
